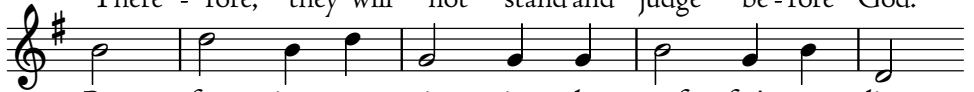

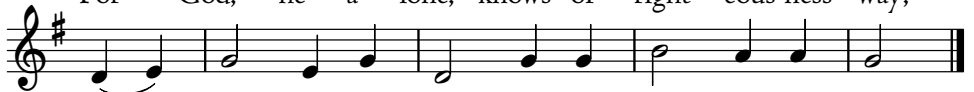
1. How blessed is the man who walks not on ad - vice
