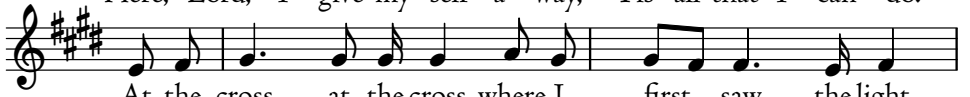
At the Cross

4. But drops of grief can ne'er re - pay The debt of love I owe:



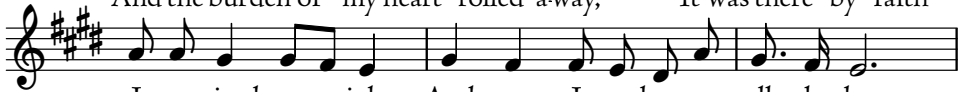
Would He de - vote that sa - cred head For such a worm as I?

Mark 16:1-8

were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" ⁴And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back—it was very large. ⁵And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. ⁶And he said to them, "Do not be alarmed.
